## I. General Business:

- a. Adopted minutes from 11/16/2016 meeting No further action required.
- **b. Membership** Borough Reorganization meeting is to be held January 7, 2017, 1:00 pm at Borough Hall. Scott Raymond is to be reappointed as a full EC Member, Ed Alter is to be moved from Alternate to Full Member, resident Adam Tate is to be appointed as a new Member, and resident Nick Orlando is to be appointed as an Alternate Member.
- Budget Meredith Kates and Scott Raymond are working on getting monthly statements from Jon DeJoseph. The EC will renew the ANJEC membership for 2017, with remaining budget funds.

## II. Correspondence – US Mail & Email:

**a. US Mail** – EC received via certified mail, notice of a law suit from a resident who tripped on a landscape planting on Town property, and sustained a foot injury.

# III. <u>Committee Updates – Tree Maintenance:</u>

- **a. NJ Transit R.O.W. Tree Damage** NJ Transit has denied Hillsdale's claim, for restitution of plant material killed by over spraying of herbicides adjacent to the rail lines within the Borough, since the plant damage is on Railroad R.O.W. property, and will not we.
- **b. Hillsdale Schools Tree Maintenance Plan** Frank Pizzella to update the EC at future meeting.
- **c.** Tree Bank Funds Borough Administrator Jon DeJoseph, has indicated that budget updates will be provided to the EC as new developer commitments are made, rather than on a monthly basis. The EC had previously requested monthly updates.

EC Member Sachiko Goodyear has given a presentation on plastic pollution to the Cub Scouts and will do so again in 2017.
- V. Committee Update Planning and Zoning: No new applications for review this time.
  - a. PSE&G Application Jon DeJoseph would like to EC to discuss with PSE&G, irrigation and maintenance of the new planting within the power station upgrades. The proposed site meeting with PSE&G representatives has been postponed due to scheduling conflicts. Andrew Lojek, PSEG project manager, has requested a "wish list" of items the EC would like them to address. The EC would like to PSE&G to provide street trees throughout the Hillsdale Environmental Zone, which would need to be coordinated with individual business owners in the Zone.

**a. SUEZ (formerly United Water) Reservoir Walkway** – Ed Alter and Frank Pizzella may do a presentation to the Watershed Review Board, regarding the trail plans. Woodcliff Lake is currently receiving engineering quotes for site work on the trail.
